

Help Desk and Relief Support for Flood-Affected Families in Kolhapur (2019)

In August 2019, severe floods affected the districts of Kolhapur and Sangli, causing widespread devastation and displacement. Thousands of families were rendered homeless, and more than two lakh people were left without electricity and access to essential services.

In response to the crisis, MASHAL implemented a flood relief support initiative to assist affected communities. The organization mobilized resources from individuals and well-wishers, collecting essential relief materials such as food grains, clothing, and other household necessities.

The collected relief materials were transported to Kolhapur and distributed with the support of local volunteers. MASHAL provided assistance to more than 30 flood-affected families in Alasgaon village, Kolhapur. The initiative focused on addressing the immediate needs of vulnerable households and helping them cope with the hardships caused by the disaster.

Through this intervention, MASHAL played an active role in coordinating relief efforts, facilitating the collection and transportation of aid materials, and ensuring that essential support reached affected families in a timely manner. The project demonstrated MASHAL's commitment to disaster response and community support during times of crisis.
