Introduction:

Lack of skills training opportunities among young women is a common issue. Unemployment is one of the major problems among the slum community, due to lack of right skills. Often, due to socio norms and financial crisis, they are unable to undertake vocational and skill trainings in the expensive training centers.

House wife women depend on the traditional work like housekeeping. Some of them do casual labor work but it produces poor earning. These are the women from underprivileged community they have not any skill and nor secure their livelihood.

This program introduces directly to skills development and will be reaching to the poor women with appropriate community mobilization and capacity building.

Project area was near the training center at Thergaon in PCMC. Mashal were identified 30 women for skill training of tailoring in Jadhav Wasti. The stitching and tailoring training duration was a 3-months, of each batch. Training were provided by a collaboration between two NGOS – MASHAL and another training institute called Sankalp Manav Vikas Sanstha. Training was up to two hours per day, 5 to 6 days per week. Training center enrolled women age between 18 to 40, had at least basic education.

Objectives:

1. To improve skill for identified women through Sewing and Tailoring classes and enable access to fair and equal opportunity.
2. Indicators -women skilled in Sewing and Tailoring.

3. Women seek livelihood opportunity through setting up of own tailoring business.

Specific Object:

To enhance the capacity and employability of 30 disadvantaged woman in vulnerable community.

To enhance the ensuring income generation opportunities of sustainable livelihood to disadvantaged 30 women through Tailoring, in Thergaon, Jadhav Wasti at PCMC area.

To ensure ability for generate income to sustainable livelihood to the poor 30 women through skill training.

Methodology used:

● Mashal had built capacity & mobilization among the community and the trainees about the importance and necessity of vocational skill ● Mashal was registered the trainees ● Provided necessary guidance to beneficiaries about the trainings, employment ability.	● Orientation meetings conducted with women in community. ● Arranged of appropriate training center for tailoring ● Organized admission process-accepting the application form selecting the 30 trainees. ● Selected 30 women beneficiaries to vocational and skill training on tailoring. ● Managed and monitored records of all 30 trainees.

Trainees	30 women trainees were responsible for undertaking learning activities with practical and theoretical capacity building initiatives.

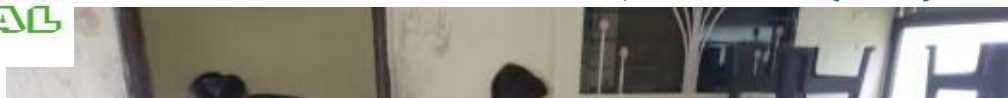
