Classroom Construction, Repair & Renovation Project

1. Project Background

Sansa is a rural village in Daudnagar Block of Aurangabad District, Bihar. Many families depend on agriculture and daily wage labour, and schools often face infrastructure challenges. The Ramanujan Science & Education Trust has been supporting education in the village, but several classrooms required repair and renovation to provide children with a safe and conducive learning environment. MASHAL partnered with the Trust to improve these learning spaces.

2. Why MASHAL is Implementing this Project

MASHAL (Maharashtra Social Housing and Action League) has over 40 years of experience in community development, housing, school infrastructure, sanitation, disaster response and participatory development. While its primary work has been in Maharashtra, MASHAL is extending its technical expertise to Bihar to support quality education and safe school infrastructure. This initiative reflects MASHAL's commitment that every child deserves a safe, dignified and inspiring place to learn, regardless of location.

3. Project Objective

- Repair and renovate classrooms.
- Strengthen damaged walls and roof.
- Improve safety and learning conditions.
- Create a clean, child-friendly environment.
- Support better educational outcomes.

4. Progress Achieved

Significant progress has been made. Structural repairs, brick masonry, roof strengthening, electrical improvements, classroom preparation and site supervision have been completed. The work is progressing according to the approved plan and quality standards.

5. Current Status

The project is progressing satisfactorily. Remaining work includes final plastering, painting, flooring repairs, electrical fittings, classroom cleaning and final inspection. The project is expected to be completed by 30 October 2026.

6. Expected Impact

Upon completion, students and teachers will benefit from safer classrooms, improved learning conditions, better protection from weather, and an enhanced school environment that supports quality education.
